CA KEHILA OF GEMS GETTING TO KNOW EACH OTHER



DAVID ZARAY-MIZRAHI

Where are you from?

I was born and raised in Los Angeles. I studied at a (non-Jewish) French school and we were regular members of R' Amram Gabay's kehila. My father is from Israel and speaks fluent French and Arabic and my mom is American so we were raised in an extremely international environment. My studies then took me to Berkeley, CA, Grenoble, France and NYC before I came to Israel. My wife, Shiran, is originally from Israel but was raised in Johannesburg, where they were members of R' Vaknin's kehila. When she was a

young adult, they moved to the Five Towns in Long Island before she made Aliyah by herself.

What languages do you speak?

I am fluent in both English and French. My Hebrew is not bad BH but my kids prove to me every day that I will never be a native speaker! My wife is fluent in both English and Hebrew.

Tell us a bit about yourself.

My wife and I often reflect in awe over the improbability of where we came from and where we are now. My spiritual journey started very much at home and in shul. When I got to university, I initially got turned off by the Jewish student scene there. During my exchange year in France, I started to learn and keep Shabbat and came back to university with determination to bring authentic Torah to campus, ~which was the first time I became an active community member~. After leaving Berkeley, I BH found spiritual mentors every place I lived, culminating in my time at the Ohr Somayach Center program, where it became clear the direction I wanted to take. To support this lifestyle and our beautiful family that Hashem blessed us with, I work as an actuary.

My wife was raised in a Bnei Akiva school. Her desire to strengthen her connection to and understanding of Hashem came during this time. After studying at FIT in NYC, she chose to make Aliyah on her own and attend Neve Yerushalayim seminary. She is an artist, with experience in graphic design but a particular passion and talent for illustration and fine art. Her art often explores spiritual and existential subject matter.

Why did you make Meam Loez your community?

After getting married and leaving yeshiva, I was in search of a Sefardi kehila and a place where I could continue the learning and growth that Ohr Somayach had provided me. When we visited RBS, I asked around for a good Moroccan kehila and was recommended to check one out on Lachish (which is today Ateret Mordechai) but I got lost and ended up at Meam Loez! My first Shabbat after moving, R' Yaacov mistook me for being from France and welcomed me in French while Rabbi Genish revealed his Angeleno upbringing and set me up with learning immediately. The signs from Above couldn't be clearer! Since then, the amazing impact of all the talmidei chachamim in the kehila has been and continues to be infinitely invaluable, not to mention the tremendous support and impact on our chinuch yeladim. This kehila delivers everything we wanted and everything we didn't know we needed!
